DWD Issuance 28-2009, 70 Percent Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Guidelines for 2010, Attachment 1

NOTE: Different 70 percent LLSIL guidelines apply to Missouri Workforce Investment Regions in the following geographical areas:

The Kansas City area that consists of Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte and Ray Counties (Kansas City and East Jackson County Region).

The St. Louis area that consists of Franklin, Jefferson, St. Charles, St. Louis City, and St. Louis Counties (Jefferson/Franklin Consortium, St. Charles County, St. Louis City and St. Louis County Regions).

The remaining counties of the state in Central, Northeast, Northwest, Ozark, South Central, Southeast, Southwest and West Central Regions.

For families larger than six (6) persons who reside in the Kansas City area, add \$4,630 for each additional member.

For families larger than six (6) persons who reside in the St. Louis area, add \$4,515 for each additional member.

For families larger than six (6) persons residing in the remainder of Missouri, add \$4,623 for each additional member.

*The guideline figures shown represent annual income.

The HHS poverty guidelines of 2009 are currently in effect:

For families with more than 8 persons, add \$3,740 for each additional person.
